A wonderfully balanced Pinot Grigio with just a hint of oak.

Dry with mineral freshness from the popular albarino grape.

Crisp, full bodied and lightly oaked.

France

Very aromatic with full fruit with good acidity and a touch of honey on the palate.

2018 Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc £23.50
Aromas of Citrus and Pears with a crisp finish.

2016 St-Véran, Domaine Botti, Pierre Janny, Maconnais £38.00
Creamy ripe fruit, with a crisp and clean finish.

2017 Vouvray, Château Gaudrelle, A. Monmousseau, Loire £38.50
Lovely and honeyed with a long, ripe finish.

2017 Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine Tabordet, Loire £44.00
A powerful, full-bodied wine with strong fruit flavours of apricots and peaches, citrus zest on the finish.

2017 Chablis, Domaine Grand Roche, Burgundy £36.50
Lovely clean fruit with balanced acidity and a dry, crisp finish.

2015 Montagny "Les Reculerons", Château de Chamilly, Burgundy £48.50
This is a fruit packed wine of great purity, a hint of flint and a streaking minerality.

Golden in colour, with a pure, gentle bouquet.

Complex, smooth and rich

A powerful expressive nose, aromas of ripe pear, white peach and vanilla with a lovely palate of fresh fruit and honeysuckle.

Classic and elegant, a rich and complex white with a mineral core.

2014 Château de Fieuzal, Pessac-Léognan, Graves, Bordeaux £72.00
Aromas of apricot, flora and honey precede a plush, concentrated palate of citrus and stone fruits.

Medium bodied, ruby in colour, with berry fruit flavours.

From Italy's Apulia region, with fresh cherry and clove aromas and a silky, structured palate.
- 2018 Primitivo, Il Pumo, Salento, Italy** £28.00
Spicy and unoaked, fruity with fresh herb aromas.
- 2017 Kore, Nero D'Avola, Colomba Bianca, Sicily** £28.00
An intense bouquet of rich brambly fruits with a seductive note of black pepper spice.
- 2016 Pena Roble, Ribera Del Duero, Spain** £31.50
Expressive aromas of red fruits, sweet cherry and hints of liquorice with oaky undertones.
- 2015 Rioja, Crianza, Conde Valdemar, Spain** £33.00
Powerful, mature berry aromas with spicy accents.

Wonderful, fruity and light but full flavoured.

Light-bodied and fresh with a vibrant spiced cherry nose and hints of violet.

Found opposite Châteauneuf du Pape, a well-structured wine, with aromas of aromatic herbs and damsons.
- 2015 Le Pigeoulet, Vaucluse, Brunier Fils, Rhône** £36.50
Old vine Grenache and a little Cabernet with full flavour and a hint of spice.
- 2017 Crozes-Hermitage, La Tuilière, Jean-Luc Colombo, Rhône** £42.00
Smooth with red berry fruits, blackcurrants and baking spice.
- 2013 Gigondas, Château de Trignon, Rhône** £60.00
Autumnal fruit, elegant tannins and a soft rounded finish
- 2016 Fleurie, Olivier Ravier, Beaujolais** £36.00
Stunning fruit aromas, both rich and refined, an ideal partner to light meats or fish
- 2016 Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Couvent Des Jacobins, Louis Jadot, Burgundy** £39.50
Silky textured yet full of plump fruitiness, with good depth and complexity.
- 2015 Mercurey, Château de Chamilly, Clos la Perrière, Côte Chalonnaise, Burgundy** £75.00
A generous and supple Pinot Noir showing blackberry and cherry fruit with a silky and spicy finish.
- 2015 Gevrey-Chambertin, “Cuvée Vieilles Vignes”, Anne & Sebastien Bidault, Burgundy** £85.00
Wonderfully robust, ripe and full flavoured.
- 2010 Château Des Joualles, Bordeaux Supérieur** £30.00
Soft and supple on the palate with notes of cedar wood, tobacco, red berry fruits and cassis.
- 2014 Château Blaignan, Cru Bourgeois, Médoc, Bordeaux** £36.50
A ripe, smooth and fruity wine with layers of tannins under the juicy blackberry flavours.
- 2015 Château La Tour de Mons, Margaux, Bordeaux** £68.50
Beautiful, rounded early drinking Margaux from this great vintage.

Soft palate with aromatic subtlety.

Great, rich flavours and well balanced and with a great structure. Magnificent!
- 2009 Château Monbousquet, Grand Cru, St-Emilion, Bordeaux** £150.00
Full bodied with concentrated and textured fruit - luscious and opulent!
- 2009 Alter Ego de Palmer, Margaux, Bordeaux** £180.00
Intense on the palate, plump and with great length.
A fantastic example of a second wine that is deftly handled by a top château.
- 1998 Château Batailley, Grand Cru Classé, Pauillac, Bordeaux** £190.00
With a lovely floral, minerally nose and damson fruit on the palate, the tannins are ripe, body medium and long length.

Rich, intense and full of velvety fruit.
- 2015 Reserve Botrytis Semillon, Berton Vineyard, Australia** £28.00/37.5cl
Intense aromas and flavours of orange rind, apricot and honey that carry through to a beautifully balanced and persistent finish.
- NV "Cristallo" Vin de Fraise, Peter Knupp, Valais, Switzerland** £50.00/37.5cl
Pure wild strawberry flavours. Clean, refreshing, beautiful and unique.
- 2015 La Fleur D'Or, Sauternes, France** £50.00/37.5cl
Apricot fruit, creamy patisserie notes and a certain citrus brightness on the nose leads to a sweet yet beautifully balanced palate.
