An intense bouquet of rich brambly fruits with a seductive note of black pepper spice.

- 2017 Reserve Botrytis Semillon, Berton Vineyard, Australia** £31.50/37.5cl
Intense aromas and flavours of orange rind, apricot and honey that carry through to a beautifully balanced and persistent finish.
- 2016 Elysium, Californian Muscat** £35.00/37.5cl
Rich, intense and full of velvety fruit.
- 2015 La Fleur D'Or, Sauternes, France** £50.00/37.5cl
Apricot fruit, creamy patisserie notes and a certain citrus brightness on the nose leads to a sweet yet beautifully balanced palate.
